INFORMATION

The Church of England Flower Arrangers' Association (CEFAA) was founded in 1981 to help and encourage all those who tend flowers in churches and to link them in fellowship and friendship. It is open to all those baptised in the Christian Faith. Each full member is registered and therefore has a vote at any meeting of the organisation. The aims are to expand interest in church flower arranging, to use talent to enrich places of worship and to use flowers as part of worship to support what theology and creation try to teach.

CEFAA is a voluntary charity whose constitution covers the work members do in churches, church buildings and at church events. The Association is not a sponsored organisation and is non-competitive. It has a junior section for those between the ages of 8 and 18. A quarterly news magazine is sent to all registered members, this contains an exchange of news, views and announcements. Our website at www.cefaa.org.uk is currently a work in progress, which we hope will develop to provide a ready point of reference for existing members and potential new recruits.

The Association was founded in the Liverpool Diocese where the Administration Office was established and where many of the National Officers were based. Members of Council represent and work for the Association across the Dioceses of the country.

Individual **Full membership** is invited from those baptised members of the Anglican Church and those Churches in fellowship with it as defined by the Council of Churches for Britain and Ireland. **Associate membership** is also available to individuals of any denomination (or none) – the only requirement being a love of floral art! Associate members do not have voting rights but enjoy all other membership benefits.
