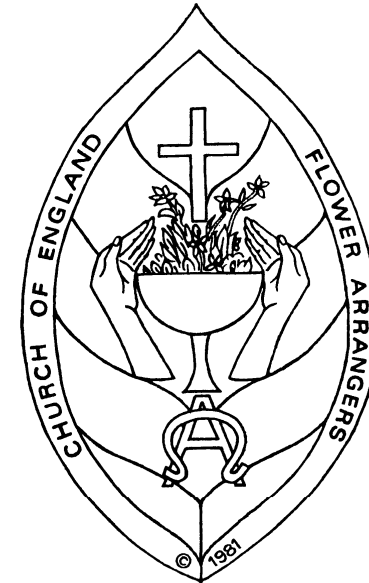

The Church of England Flower Arrangers' Association (CEFAA) was founded in 1981 to help and encourage all those who tend flowers in churches and to link them in fellowship and friendship. It is open to all those baptised in the Christian Faith. Each member is registered and therefore has a vote at any meeting of the organisation. The aims are to expand interest in church flower arranging, to use talent to enrich places of worship and to use flowers as part of worship to support what theology and creation try to teach.

The Association was founded in the Liverpool Diocese where the Administration Office was established and where many of the National Officers were based. Members of Council represent and work for the Association across the Dioceses of the country. CEFAA is a voluntary charity whose constitution covers the work members do in churches, church buildings and at church events. The Association is not a sponsored organisation and is non-competitive.
